WELCOME TO BEYOND THE SCREEN

A New Erasmus+ Project to Empower Online Educators.

The shift to online education has transformed teaching—but it has also brought new challenges for educators. Many adult trainers, teachers, and tutors struggle with motivation, engagement, and well-being in digital environments. That's why Beyond the Screen was born: to equip educators with practical tools, peer support, and innovative resources to thrive in long-term online teaching.

Funded by Erasmus+ (KA220-ADU), this 24-month project brings together five European organizations to develop :

A self-assessment tool for educators to identify their motivation profiles and skill gaps.

An interactive e-trainers manual with vidcasts (animated/recorded videos) and comic strips for engaging learners.

A peer-to-peer support network to share best practices and sustain motivation.

Our goal?

To put educators' well-being at the heart of digital education—because motivated educators create inspired learners.

What happened so far ?

Kick-Off Meeting (November 2025, Bulgaria): Partners gathered in Sofia to launch the project, finalize the work plan, and discuss the self-assessment tool's framework

What's next ?

Blended Workshop (October 2026, Cyprus): 15 educators from across Europe will test the self-assessment tool, explore vidcasts and comic strips, and co-create content for the Interactive E-Trainers Manual.

First Vidcasts and Comic Strips (Late 2026): Pilot versions of the animated videos and comic strips will be released for feedback. Stay tuned for sneak peeks!
